1. A PASSIONATE APPROACH

SALVATION IS NEVER A MATTER OF EXTERNAL REFORMATION!

Matthew 5:43–44

INTERNAL TRANSFORMATION LEADS TO EXTERNAL MANIFESTATION!

1 Corinthians 6:9–10 1 John 2:3–6 1 John 3:17

The rich man was willing to have Jesus as a teacher to respect, but not to have Jesus as a Lord to obey, and there is a huge difference.

Jesus is not an advice giver.

He is the one who determines your steps.

Jesus decides what house you live in, not you.

Jesus decides what car you drive, not you.

Jesus decides what clothes you wear.

Jesus decides what you spend your \$'s on.

Jesus sets your budget.

Jesus decides what you invest in.

Jesus decides what lifestyle you live according to, not you or me,

Jesus makes these calls.

2. A PASSIONATE AFFECTION

I suggest the least that we can do is pray about selling all the stuff that we don't need and give to the poor.

Matthew 25 Romans 8

3 A PASSIONATE COMMAND

Jesus gives commands, not considerations.

Mark 10:21 (NIV) Jesus looked at him and loved him. "One thing you lack," he said. "Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

Five different commands.

- 1. Go
- 2. Sell everything you have
- 3. Give to the poor
- 4. Come
- 5. Follow me

Jesus required obedience here, the same way he requires obedience from you and me today.

What specific action do you believe God is asking you to take now?

What are impediments do you have to living this out?

In what areas is God asking you to move from being 'willing to obey God' as opposed to 'obeying God'? What will help you make those changes?

Read Luke 12:16-21, 32-34

What does this passage reveal to us about God?

What does it say to you personally?

What does it mean to be, 'rich towards God'? Are there any changes for you in this regard?

John at this point in his message encouraged us all to ask Christ...

"What do you want me to give away? What do you want me to sell?

Share where you are up to with this searching challenge? Pray for each other as you listen to Christ.
