

## Questions for Robin Cullen sermon 'Intro to The Gospel Of John', 3/3/13

1. What impacted you out of Robin's sermon

2. Read John 20:30,31.

Explain John's purpose for writing the book to others in your group (in your own words). How does John's purpose affect you?

3. Robin mentioned that truth must be in the context of all truth, or it becomes an untruth.

Eg John 8:32 Jesus says if you know the truth it will set you free, but that is not always true. The condition in 8:31 must be in place (obedience).

4. Can you think of other verses where this is often wrongly applied?

Are there examples in your own life where you have wrongly applied verses.

5. The pattern of John is:

Testimony (witness) produces response which produces result

The response is either faith (belief) or unbelief and the result is life or death.

What are some examples of these in John's gospel?

What are some examples in your own life of this?

6. Some key words through John are:

Sign (supernatural), witness, believe and life (eternal)

Notice these as you read through John

Eg. Read John 11 and notice when 'BELIEVE' is used. What do you notice?
