## Questions for sermon on John 1:35-51, Come and see by David Stanford

1. Read through John 1:35-51 and note all the different names or descriptions of Jesus. Eg Lamb of God.

What does each one add to the understanding of who Jesus is? What is the significance for us today? Which of the names of Jesus has the most significance to you personally? Explain why.

- 2. Which of the 4 named men in the passage who responded to Jesus, do you resinate with the most? Who is most like you in your response to Christ?
- 3. Reflect on the people who played a part in you understanding and following Christ? Share about one of these with your group.

  Take some time to thank God for these ones and also to pray for the ones in your world who you believe God has you there to be a Philip or Andrew
- 4. What is your personal attitude toward telling others about Jesus? How do the examples of John, Andrew and Philip help you? What helpful insights did you receive from David's sermon on this?
- 5. In Genesis 28, read the story of Jacob and his dream. As you read the dialogue Jesus had with Nathanael, what do you notice about the connection with the Genesis 28 story? So what?
