

Questions from Easter Sunday 2013-03-28

1. In your group, share personally about a significant Easter in your life. It may be a lighter time or a very impacting time.
2. On a scale of 1-10, where 1 is unbelief to the max and 10 is belief to the max, what number would you rank yourself in terms of your belief in the truth of the resurrection of Jesus.
Dialogue about it in your group. How is that evident in your life?
3. What helps you believe in the resurrection?
4. Read the story in Luke 24:13-49 of the interaction of Jesus with the disciples.
 - What emotions were present? What were the concerns?
Do you identify with them?
 - Why did the disciples not recognise Jesus? Can you think of times when you did not recognise Jesus walking with you?
 - What was offered to the disciples by Jesus being alive?
 - What do you notice Jesus did in verses 27, 32, 43-47? Why did he do that?
 - What helps you believe in the resurrection?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-20. What really grabs you from that passage?
6. What is the significance of Scripture for us in our faith journey?
7. Pray for your unbelieving friends that they will put their faith in Jesus.
