Questions for John 2:12-25 (David Stanford)

Read John 2:12-25 together

- 1. What surprised you out of this passage?
- 2. What hinders people finding and experiencing God:
 - a. in our church?
 - b. in your life?

What actions can you take on this?

3. What helps people find and experience God in our church and in your life? What action can you take with this? What helps you experience God?

- 4. Which story of disruption that David shared connected with you the most?
- 5. How has God disrupted, or is disrupting, your life or turned/turning your tables over?

Talk about how God has transformed you through this.

6. David compared how people see coming to Christ. One view is that we are joined by God and He continues with us helping us in our life. The other view was of us jumping into the river of God and joining Him in His agenda and His purposes.

What do you think about these viewpoints? Assuming the second one is true, what difference does that make in your life?

7. Read 1 Corinthians 6:18-20. What does this mean in the context of this sermon? What does it mean for you?

8. The Jews asked Jesus for a sign.(vs18) How are you like the Jews? How does His answer impact you?

9. If you have been baptised, talk about the significance of that for you. If you have not been baptised, in light of this message, what is stopping you? Action!!!
