1. What did you learn from the little boy?
2. Why did the crowd follow Jesus?
3. Jesus asks Philip a question to test him vv5-6. What do you think the test is meant to reveal?
4. How do you think the disciples felt as they gathered up the leftovers vv12,13?
5. After Jesus fed the multitude, what did they want to do to him? How did Jesus react to this and why?
6. What insights does this passage give you into how Jesus may be at work in the various and maybe difficult situations of your life?
7. How do you usually respond to an 'impossible situation' – a problem in your life that doesn't seem to have a solution?
8. Spend time praying for each other in any of the impossible situations you be experiencing now. Give thanks for the times when God has come through.
