- 2. What do the shouts of the crowd tell us about their expectations of Jesus (vs 12-19)?
- 3. How did Jesus statements about His mission clash with the crowds expectations (vs23-28)? How do these verses impact you?
- 4. What is the significance of Jesus prayer in vs 28? Share about situations where you have prayed that prayer for your situation? Is this a prayer that can be prayed in any situation? What are we saying when we pray that prayer?
- 5. How does verse 28b (The Father's response) encourage you?
- 6. In verses 37-50 the word 'believe' is mentioned how many times. What is the significance of this word in this context? Remember John 20:31.
- 7. Chat about the responses of people in vs 37, 39,42,43. Talk about your own life where these responses were your responses.
- 8. Jesus last public address to His people is recorded in vs 44-50. What indications do you find that He is still reaching out in love and grace to those who have rejected Him?
- 9. How has this passage helped you talk to a person who is:
 - interested in becoming a Christian oror
 - in need of Christ but not interested in believing in Christ
