Questions for John 17 Sermon

Have one person Read/Pray through John 17

What impact does knowing Jesus prayed this for you, and continues to pray this for you, have on you?

Glory and glorify are mentioned often. Share with each other what they mean.

The only request for Himself is that the Father would glorify Him so He might glorify His Father. Why was that so important to Jesus?

What could change in you so that God's glory is more a priority for you?

Read Matthew 5:16. Share how you have noticed the others in your group glorify God.

What specifically impacts you about what Jesus prays for the disciples in verses 6-19?

In verses 11,15 Jesus prays for protection for His disciples. Why would that be important for Jesus at that time?

Jesus prays for us to be sanctified through the Word. How can we cooperate with God in that? What hinders that?

In his sermon David mentioned that; 'Unity is a fruit of glory'. What does that mean to you? Read verses 21-23.

In what practical ways can we demonstrate our oneness with other believers? What are the results of unity?

What are the results of disunity?

Why do you think Jesus prays for believers and there is no indication of him praying for non believers?

From this chapter, what do you believe is Jesus priority for us?
