## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Read Luke 1:38-45. In what ways is Mary portrayed as an ideal believer?
- 2. Mary believed God for the impossibility of the virgin birth of the Son of God. How does this inspire your faith to believe God for the impossible? Are there impossible situations that you are facing that needs God's intervention? Please share.
- 3. What are some of the promises of God that you have come to trust from reading his Word? (Also see 2Corinthians 1:20)
- 4. Read Luke 1:46-49. In view of Mary's example, does your belief in God lead you to worship and pray without asking for nothing?
- 5. Read Luke 1:50-56. Notice the distinction that Luke makes between the proud and the humble. Then, discuss the three dangerous P's of Pride, Politics and Power and their influence in society and even in your life. Follow this by discussing how the Scriptures speak to this particularly as it relates to humility and service and how these impact your own life.
- 6. Are there personal things that God has shown you and you have sensed that the Lord will bring them about? Do they line up with the word of God? Have you seen them fulfilled?
