Questions Keith Farmer February 16 sermon: Compassion

 Christianity in Australia is not going well. Keith shared that recent research in Australia revealed the 10 major blockages to people believing in Jesus are:

Church abuse Hypocrisy Judging others Religious wars Suffering Money issues Outdated Hell and condemnation Homosexuality Exclusivity

- 2. Which of these hindered you coming to faith? What helped you get past those issues?
- **3.** Which of these could be evident in your life and thus hinder people believing in Jesus?
- 4. Keith mentioned '*judging others*' (superiority and smugness) was an issue for him. How do we/you judge others today? What may be the reasons for that? Any suggestions as to how we deal with this issue?
- 5. Compassion was and is always demonstrated by Jesus. How would you describe or define compassion?
- 6. Give examples of: Where people have shown you compassion? Where you have shown others compassion?
- 7. Read Mark 6:30-44

Compare how Jesus and the disciples viewed the crowd? How did this impact their actions? What does that say to you?

- 8. What pictures or words would you use to describe God? Keith shared that Luke 15:20 is the picture that best describes God. Comment on that.
- 9. Keith shared that compassion involves courage and strength, it is resilient and dangerous. Comment on that regarding Jesus' compassion and your compassion.
- 10. In Colossians 3:12-14, Paul commands us to 'clothe ourselves with compassion'. What does that involve for you?
- 11. Romans 9: 14,15 we read (The Message); God told Moses, "*I*'*m* in charge of mercy. *I*'*m* in charge of compassion." Compassion doesn't originate in our bleeding hearts or moral sweat, but in God's mercy.

Compassion is not something we try to do better; it originates in the heart of God.

What does this mean for you?

- 12. The research mentioned earlier revealed these top 2 responses to the question; what might help you to be open to Christianity?
 - Events in life that cause me to re-examine how I live
 - Someone close to me who lives it out in such a way that shows it (Christianity) is working
