1. What is your response to John's statement that Evangelism is something we all just do as we go?

Matthew 28: 18–20 (NIV) Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹**Therefore go and (And as you go) make disciples** of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

2. What are your biggest challenges to giving an answer to everyone who asks you for the reasons why you believe?

1 Peter 3: 15–16 (NIV) But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, ¹⁶keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.

3. How important is it to be gentle in response to people?

4. What do think it means that relational evangelism is firstly about your relationship with the Lord?

5. Is relational evangelism a process and not a 1 off event? Why?

6. Was John right when he said that Jesus didn't share with any two individuals the same way, the same information? Dialogue on this. What does this mean for us?

7. Share about the people who helped you come to Jesus. Talk about a person who you have helped come to Christ. What do you notice in these stories?
