## "Every Christ follower actively involved in Ministry"

- 1. Read Galatians 5 together you might like to read the NIV version & then the message translation.
- 2. "Expectations". What comes to mind when you hear the word "expectations"? What "expectations" do you sometimes bring with you to church even if you're not conscious of them?
- 3. "You are not a commodity to Christ and the church and neither should the church and Christ be a commodity to you. We need to get off that treadmill." How do you respond to this quote from Tania's message?
- 4. Talk about the contrast between life on the treadmill & life walking by the river of life with Jesus. Did you find this analogy helpful? Why or why not?
- 5. Point 1. Active participation as a follower of Jesus is not motivated by rules. Re-read verses 16-18 & discuss
- 6. Point 2. Active participation as a follower of Jesus is always motivated by Christian love.

  Re-read verses 13-15 & discuss. "Love causes us to want to identify with the people God calls us to serve." How do you respond to this quote from Tania's message?
- 7. Point 3. It's in our DNA to be an active participant in the life of Jesus not just in church but everywhere!

  Re-read verses 22-23. Talk about the analogy: "Life is a peach and not on orange." How do you respond to this?
- 8. How can you participate in the life of Christ for each other out of this message? How will you/can you encourage one another to be active participants in the life of Christ?
