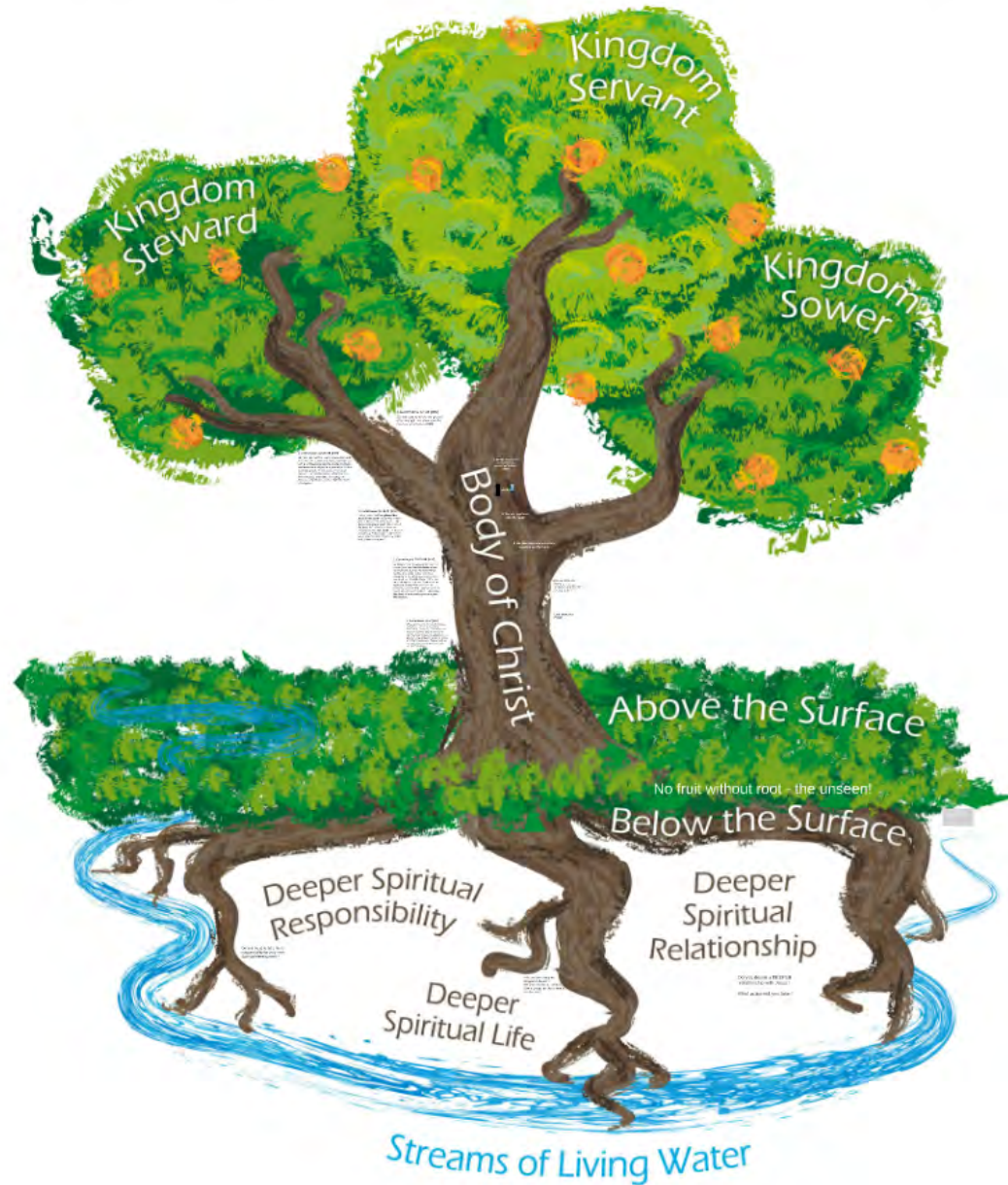


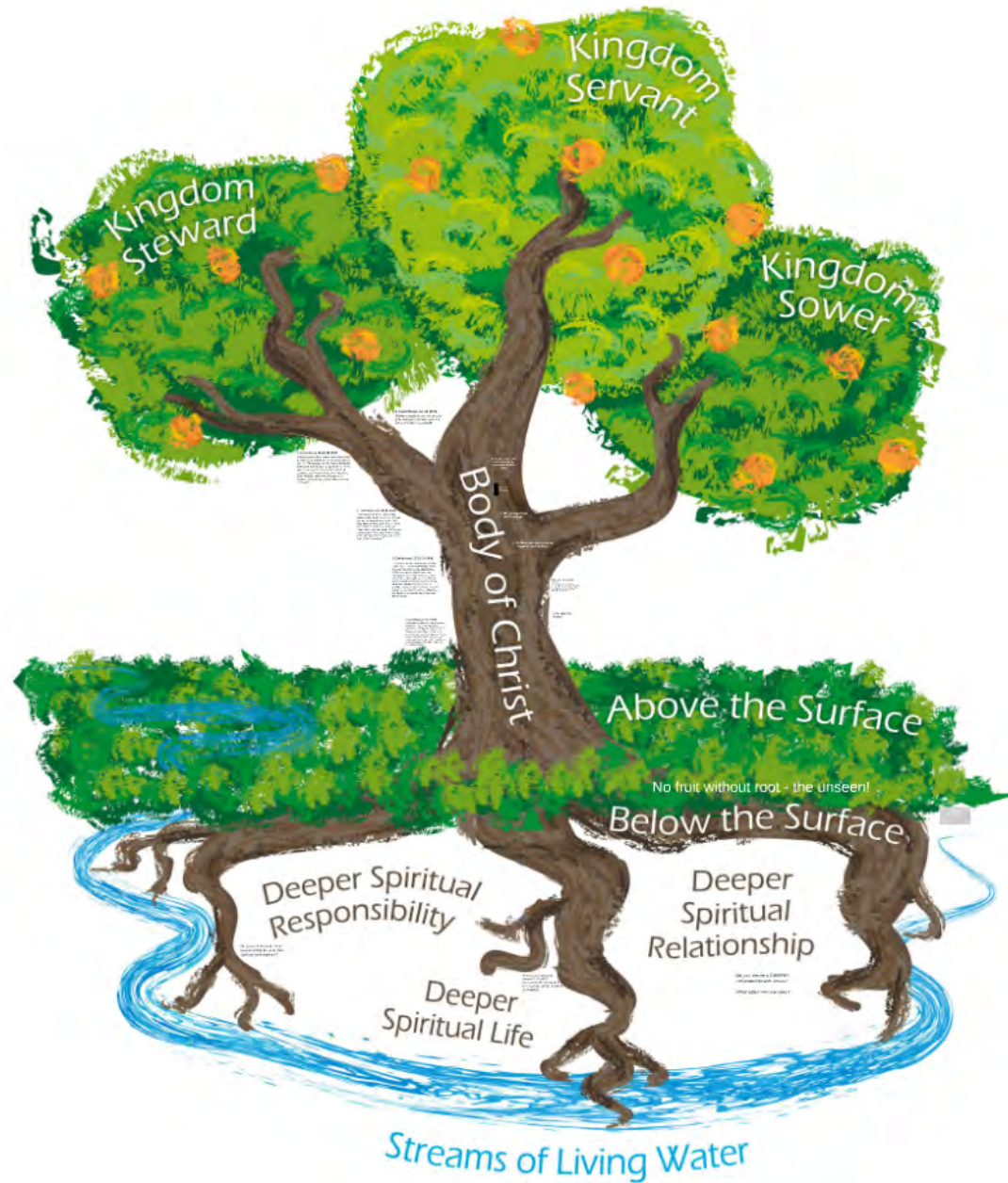

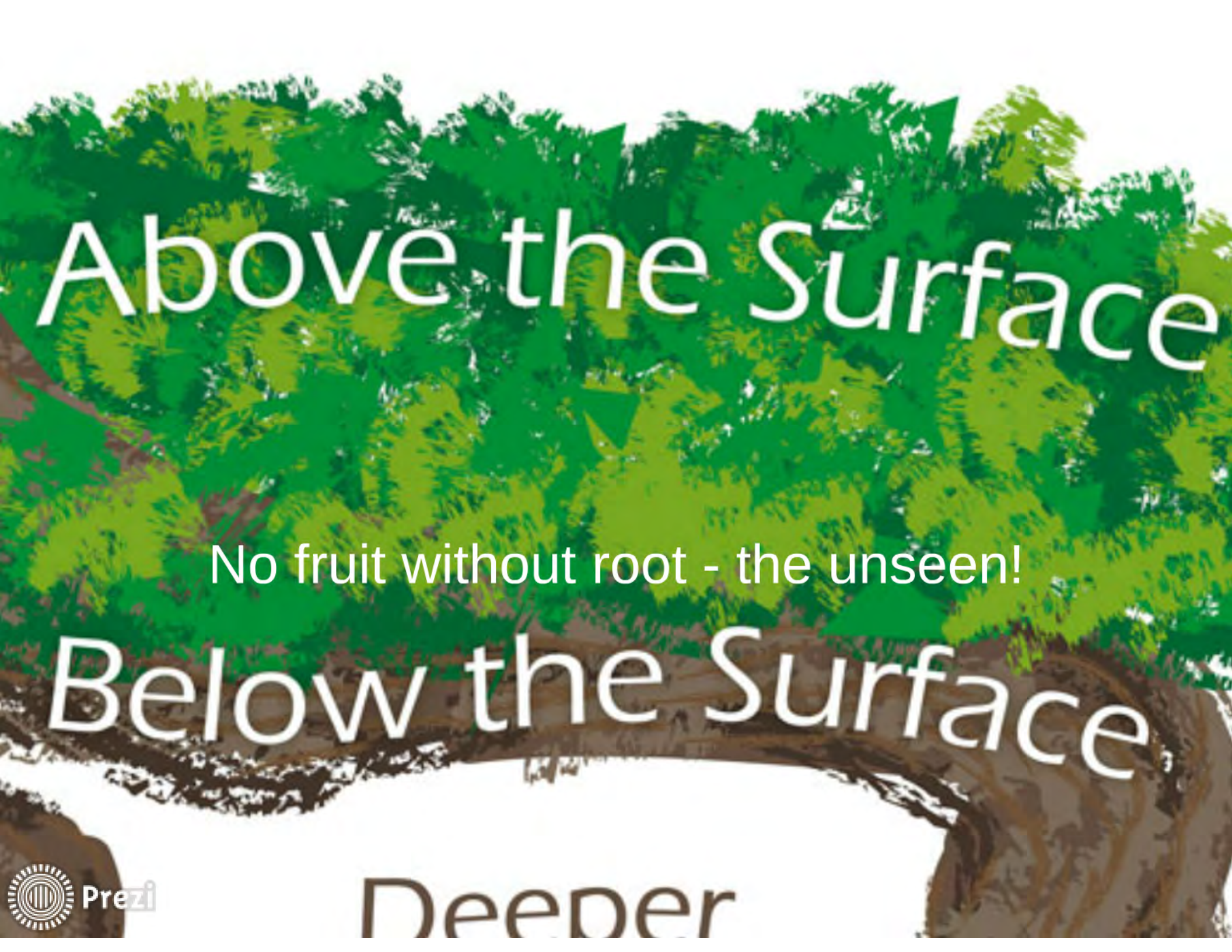

1 Corinthians 12:25-28 (NIV)  
And the Spirit makes us all share in each other's sufferings, so that when one suffers, we all suffer, because we are members of his body, joined to his flesh and to his bones. We share in his sufferings, sharing in the life of the Spirit. Do not be jealous or boastful because of one another, since you are all members of one another's bodies.

1 Corinthians 12:18-21 (NIV)  
God has placed each of us in the body as he wills, for the glory of the church, the fullness of his body, which is complete when all the parts are working properly. But in the church, the parts that seem weaker and less honorable are given the greater honor, so that the church will be built up in love. We are his body, joined to his flesh and to his bones. We share in his sufferings, sharing in the life of the Spirit.

1 Corinthians 12:31-34 (NIV)  
But as each of us has received a special gift from the Spirit, we should use it to serve one another, just as the church serves Christ, his body, of which he is the head. He saves and builds up his body with his word, so that he can present it to himself in glory, without any stain or wrinkle or anything of the kind, but holy and blameless.
